The current BOE parking lot is at the end of its useful life. There is severe cracking and degradation throughout the parking lot and (2) egress entrances and exits. The parking lot is also mshared be the neighboring church and daycare provider. Proposed work would be to remove 24,000 square feet of bituminous asphalt and install (2) new courses of bituminous asphalt; 2" base layer with 1.5" wear layer. Work would need to be conducted around the D-box access heads for the septic, as well as the tank access area. The contractor would also install new bituminous curbing on the left and right sides of the lot. Special consideration would be made around the sidewalk access area to the front steps. Cost for the work is approx.-\$90,000.
