PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The warning transition strips at Tolland High School that are required by code to warn the blind of impending traffic have disintegrated and heaved. This has created tripping hazards and they have ceased to be functional as warning strips.

Current strips are Armor-Mat style and original to school construction in 2005 Three options will be explored to replace:

- 1. Installation of pre-fabricated cement blocks roughly 6" x 3" that have the imprints
- 2. Installation of concrete and then fabrication of a stamp of warning transition pattern
- 3. Installation of cast iron mats that are set into the concrete

Two vendors have been approached already for estimates:
